You can apply if...

You have:



- at least 3 unrelated people on your governing body
- a UK bank account in the name of your organisation with at least two unrelated signatories
- Annual accounts or projections for 12 months

You can:

- send BIG an application at least three months before your project is planned to start
- complete your project within one year of when BIG confirms your award

Reaching Communities

Two strands



- Reaching Communities revenue, and small buildings projects under £100k
- Two stage application process
- No eligibility checker
- Reaching Communities capital upper limit cap on total project cost now removed
- Three stage application process
- Eligibility checked by postcode (Lower Super Ouput Areas
- Exceptions process in place

Reaching Communities – Swindon & Wiltshire 2013-2014



- 39 applications received
- £765k awarded
- 8% success (28% nationally)

Reaching Communities

Capability Building Support

- A two year programme
- Revenue projects invited to stage 2
- Capital projects invited to stage 3
- Additional funding to develop an organisation's knowledge, skills and confidence
- 10% of project cost up to a maximum of £15,000



Reaching Communities

Capability Building Support



- Strength Based Assessment Review to identify key strengths and weaknesses
- Organisation chooses support provider
- Completed within 12 weeks
- Spent within first 12 months

Power to Change

Kickstarting Community Action Across England



We want to help more people respond to local need and opportunity, and change the places in which they live for the better.

Will invest up to £150 million to support the development of sustainable community-led enterprises through an independent grant-making Trust from autumn 2014.

Will fund both revenue and capital projects and is focussed on a place based approach to resolving community issues through enterprise.

Power to Change What is a community enterprise?



For the purpose of our funding they will be

- Endorsed by or engaging with local people
- Led by a charity, social enterprise or not-for profit or member (co-operative) organisation
- Benefitting a specific geographical place
- Provides a direct response to local social and economic need or opportunity
- Aims for sustainability/viability at the end of grant funding

Power to Change



The Trust will be able to work with and complement the existing providers in the marketplace without duplicating what they have to offer.
